CALL US - BEFORE YOUR EX DOES!

Q

My wife and I settled our issues at court. The Order says that she has our children Christmas mornings on even years, and I have them on odd years. Now she is taking our children to Disney World from the 21st -28th and she says I can see the kids when they get back. I want my Christmas morning with our kids this year! What can I do?

A

Provide your wife with a copy of the Order by email and remind her that this is your year to have the children for Christmas, and her Disney World plans interfere with the court Order.

Tell her that you expect confirmation via email in 48 hours that you will have the children for the 2019 Christmas schedule in the court Order. failing which you will bring a motion to have this access enforced. Advise her that bribing the children with a trip is not OK. There are 365 days in the year- she can pick a week that does not involve your holiday access. If no/negative response, re-send the email again and text her. Keep a copy of the emails and texts, and responses.

Do not delay in setting up a court date; the sooner you book a court date the sooner

you will have peace of mind. The Family Law Information Center (FLIC) at the courthouse can help you with this process, but if this is all overwhelming, I strongly suggest that you retain a family lawyer.

A word of caution- If you let this issue go, you do so at your peril as you will have confirmed in your ex-spouses's mind, that she can ignore the Order anytime she wants, as it suits her, with no repercussions. This does not bode well for you and your children's future.
