My wife just told me she wants a divorce. We have been married for 46 years! What is going on?

Just as the baby boomers changed society in our youth, so are we affecting seniors divorce rates. World-wide, divorce rates are jumping for persons in long-term marriages.

In Canada, according to Zoomer Magazine, divorce is spiking only among 50-plusers and becoming increasingly common for couples aged 65 or older. It is such a common trend it is now called "grey divorce".

Many times it is the woman who pulls the plug on the marriage - according to a 2004 study by A.A.R.P., women initiated the breakup to a long marriage 66% of the time. And yes, they report that most husbands don't see it coming, so you are not alone
